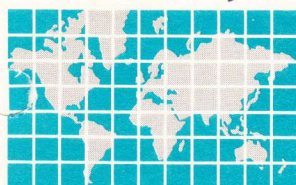

Thank you for submitting the abstract of your contributed paper  
or poster for presentation at ICIAM 91. I am pleased to report  
to you that we are accepting it for presentation.

Reference to your paper will appear in the Preliminary Program  
which should be in the mail in the third week of February. It  
will show the time and date of your presentation.

Many of you have asked questions about registration fees for the  
conference. We have not finalized the fee yet, but I can say  
that it will be in the range of US\$175-\$185.

The Preliminary Program will contain complete instructions  
regarding hotel and dormitory accommodations. The Sheraton  
Washington in Washington, D.C., will be the host hotel for the  
conference with room rates of US\$99 for a single and US\$119 for  
a double plus taxes (11% sales plus \$1.50 per night occupancy).  
Also, we have blocks of rooms at nearby hotels to handle any  
overflow that cannot be accommodated at the Sheraton and  
dormitory accommodations at US\$23 for shared occupancy and  
US\$30 for single occupancy at local universities. Some of you  
have asked about financial assistance for participation in  
ICIAM 91. We regret there are no funds available for that  
purpose.
