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


• Evaluation criteria:	Evaluation criteria: • Informed consent • Current lithium therapy, Previous use of GBP • Medications • Medications • Other diseases • Decrease in the score at the three EFRS items considered for inclusion. • Response rate is % of patients with a mean score of the three EFRS score at the end of the visit versus baseline • Total EFRS score at the end of the visit versus baseline • Score at the subscores of EFRS rating psychopath items 6, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, and mania (items 1, 2, 19, 20), depressive items 3, 4, 5, 16, 17, 18, and neutral items 8, 21, 22, 23) symptoms
• Secondary efficacy criteria:	• Time to improve, • Side effects were collected at every visit. • Side effects were collected at every visit.
• Concentration Nf therapy	A standard NL therapy was given to all the patients at the time of hospitalization. The preferred NL used was haloperidol, at a dose of 4 mg/kg/day.
• Dosage criteria:	An AV 1, the daily dose of NL following weeks
